However, not all artists and certainly not all art forms have been able to match up to the evolving times which has resulted in artists facing deprivation and lack of patronage or adequate renumeration for their creations which has led to certain art forms losing on their charm and elan. Since we belong to a culture which boasts of having propagated 64 traditional arts known as the "Chausath Kalas", there is a need to address this prevailing issue so as to progressively develop our culture through various forms of art. The Arts Leadership Council will endeavour to achieve this aim through employment of direct, definitive measures focused towards development of all forms of art to include all branches of Literature, Visual & Performing Arts.

Vision

Build a culturally enriched nation which acknowledges all forms of art and artists. Nurture a social ecosystem that gives recognition and patronage to art and artists while ensuring their rights and economic independence. Develop a heritage that will nurture art and artists from all disciplines providing them new avenues for growth.

<u>Mission</u>

The Arts Leadership Council at WICCI will endeavour towards achieving the enshrined vision through a mission-oriented approach on the following issues: -

1. <u>Create Awareness Among Artists Regarding Royalty Issues</u>. Sec 53A of the Copyright Act has, since 1994, ensured royalty for artists for the sale and resale of their original creations. However, awareness regarding this provision among the artists is very limited. The Art Leadership Council will work to increase awareness regarding this among the artists as also empower and assist them in securing their rights.



- 2. <u>Skill Development</u>. Training in development of right skill is essential for any domain so as to ensure its survival in the long run. Art, in all its forms is no exception to this. The council shall focus efforts towards development of skill centres, islands of excellence and design skill development programmes which will give an opportunity to artists to develop their skillsets to match with the demands of evolving times.
- 3. <u>Create Opportunities in MSME for Artists</u>. Grass root level enterprises such as agricultural, rural industries, and various other businesses are supported by MSME to boost homegrown brands and empower people to make in India. The same can be of great help to artists. The ministry has implemented Micro and Small Enterprises a Cluster Development program wherein they provide the business help with awareness, counselling, motivation, training, and much more. The ministry also conducts various types of training and skill development programs which can be of major help to artists. The Art Leadership Council shall work towards creating opportunities for artists through assistance in formation of clusters in sectors viable for the artists.
- **6.** <u>Microfinancing Schemes for Artist</u>. Financial help and support system for artists is currently limited to the patronage they are able get endorsement for through their networking abilities in the form of grants or commissions from a sponsor. The council shall work in collaboration with government agencies and other financial institutions at bringing about financial help for artists through microfinancing schemes so as to help their artistic venture thereby making them active participants in the growth of the economy.
- **8.** <u>Promoting Functioning of Artists Guilds</u>. Artists guilds, work at providing opportunities for the growth of art as well as at safeguarding their interests. The council shall work in collaboration with such guilds at regional, national and international levels to enhance art and develop artists.



- 6. <u>Reviving Traditional Art Forms</u>. There are several ancient art traditions in the Indian culture which have been lost due to the lack of patronage, challenging economic situations, and a competitive environment and inadequate advertising which is the need of the hour given the information centric world that we live in. The Art Leadership Council shall endeavour to revive these traditional art forms by providing them the required platform to showcase their potential thereby creating opportunities.
- **8.** <u>Building an Artists Network.</u> One of the key areas wherein the council shall focus its efforts will be towards building a sustainable network of artists. '*Building your network is like building your net worth*' is the apt axiom for the VUCA world that we live in today. Networking being the need of the hour, the Art Leadership Council shall work to build a support system for the artists which will help them grow with the right opportunity at the right time as also help the fraternity keep abreast with changing times.
- 9. Organise Events for Better Strength of the Network. A little effort, an opportunity, and a platform can change the face of art in India today. Creating a platform where artists from across the country can come, share their work, find support groups to help them grow their business, and up their skill is a great way to encourage this. Organising events for better strength of the network is one of the best ways to bring these talented and creative people under one roof and discuss the future of art and artists in these modern times. Such a movement will help promote, facilitate, and develop the competitiveness of the artists, which shall be one among the prime endeavours of the Arts Leadership Council.
- 9. <u>Art Exchange Programs</u>. Art and cultural exchange programs are an efficient medium to enhance intercultural understanding. The council shall work to organise such exchanges and partnerships so as to connect individuals, institutions, and communities from around the world

Beena Unnikrishnan is an artist, entrepreneur and a movie maker who, inspired by the call of the mystic traditions, is in a continuous quest at giving manifestation to the hues of the ethereal energy that brings balance to this world through *Purusha* and *Prakriti*.

Prominent works from her elaborate portfolio as an artist include the series of the 'Chausat (64) Yoginis' depicting the aura of Shakthi with her demi-goddesses in all her manifestations. As a sequel to this she is also in the process of writing a book on "Unleashing the Power of the Feminine Within". The Nakshatra series, which is a set of 30 paintings, is yet another example of her experiments at amalgamating Tantra with art which encapsulate the correlation that exists between the journey of the moon and that of the soul; a visual representation of the ancient Indian science of astrology or Jyotishya.

Film making was yet another journey that she embarked upon as a part of her inklings towards creativity and exploring a medium that can manifest an idea in a lifelike manner. As the CEO of *Iris Green Films*, she produced "*Maiyaa*", a film that addresses the loneliness of the elders or the aged. She has also made two short films, "*Home is Where the Heart is*" and "*Antaraal*", for All Ladies League (ALL), India Cinema Chapter. Through her films she endeavours to address social issues that were always the core identities to our culture but are being overlooked as we progress towards development.

Through her research fellowship on "Application of Cognitive Dynamics through Art in Alzheimer's and Dementia Patients", she explored and studied the power of art in stimulating all the five senses. She has, since then, endeavoured at utilising images and colours that have psychological and behavioural effects on the observer. For her work in this field she was awarded the Senior Fellowship Award from the Ministry of Culture, Government of India.

She is, at present, the National President, Arts Leadership Council at Women's Indian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (WICCI); India's First National Business Chamber for Women and the India Chapter Chairperson for Cinema at All Ladies League (ALL). She was awarded the "Exceptional Women of Excellence" honour by the Women Economic Forum.

A gender historian, her research interests range from the histories of Bengali Hindu widows of colonial Bengal to the journey of modern-contemporary dance of India. She is presently writing on exotic-erotic dance that thrives at the interface of sexual labour, migration and human trafficking.

.Her edited book includes *Ranjabati, A Dancer and Her World* (2008) and *The Moving Space: Women in Dance* (2017) (with Urmimala Sarkar) as she has also contributed papers /chapters in several edited volumes. She has recently authored two monographs in Bengali *Kolkatar Nach: Samakaleen Naranritya*, (2019) and *Kolkatar Cabaret: Bangali, Younata ebang Miss Shefali* (2020).

A grantee of **Arts Research Documentation** program funded by **Indian Foundation for the Arts** (IFA) Bengaluru, Aishika explored the history of contemporary dance in Bengal seen through the perspectives of two feminist performers, Dr Manjusri Chaki-Sircar and Ranjabati Sircar, who happened to be her own dance mentors

Trained in contemporary Indian dance, Aishika has a parallel journey as a dancer. She has long been associated with *Dancers' Guild*, an institute set up by Manjusri Chaki-Sircar, and traveled widely to participate important national and international dance festivals. Her own choreographies with the Guild (*Jajnaseni* and *Chitrangada*) won critical accolade and *Chitrangada* was staged at the prestigious *Tagore Festival* in Egypt (2017).
