


RICHA GHOSH, PRESIDENT

Anshul is a goal oriented power woman with a strong interest in yoga and cycling.






DEEPTI KAMRA, COUNCIL MEMBER




RAMYA RAVINDRA, COUNCIL MEMBER

'Trekking in the mountains, swimming in the sea or being on the move, is my lifeline', says this intrepid traveler.






APARNA GHATWAL, COUNCIL MEMBER
