All this while her first love remained textiles. Soon she found her way into a textile export house, purely through her knack of designing sarees and clothes for family and friends. This understanding of the Indian psyche quickly moved her to greater heights of excellence in textile design and merchandising, working with the likes of Armani, DKNY, Kenzo, Dries van Noten, Sonia Rykiel, Etro et al. To understand the fashion and study the market she travelled to Europe regularly. The demand for the best qualities at rock bottom prices made her go to the heartlands of India, where she finally discovered her vision.

A strong commitment to recycling, even before it was popular, found her at the 2006 Ethical Fashion Show in Paris, France, where her prime focus was on recycling of natural fibres/textiles and she showed a collection dedicated to Art Nouveau using traditional Indian hand embroidery and block printing. This remains her motto, and Nextiles has developed products with recycled and upcycled textiles and fibres. She has received Swayam Siddha award from the Rotary for her contribution in textiles and the life of the artisans. Almost simultaneously she began working in films as a Costume designer establishing a reputation for authenticity, especially in period cinema. Her work on Koyekti Meyer Gawlpo brought her the best costume designer award at the Madrid International Film Festival in 2013.


